AFCCE SCHOLARSHIPS

Applicants will be considered for all scholarships for which they are eligible. AFCCE has four scholarships available, each with different qualifications. Three scholarships are available for upper-division (Junior and Senior) students and graduate students; one scholarship is available to lower-division (including community college) students. Only one application needs to be filled out for consideration of all scholarships.

AFCCE Scholarship (typically \$500 to \$2,500)

IEEE BTS/AFCCE Jules Cohen Memorial Scholarship (\$5,000 or \$10,000 with a cumulative limit of \$15,000)

(For the IEEE BTS/AFCCE Jules Cohen Memorial Scholarship, an expressed interest in broadcast engineering or technology is required)

E. Noel Luddy Memorial Scholarship (up to \$2,500)

To be considered for the above three scholarships, applicants must:

- Be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate or graduate student in an accredited program in a 4-year institution located in the United States or Canada.
- Have junior or senior standing for semester being applied for (undergraduates only).
- Graduate students must be enrolled in an accredited Master's or Doctorate program.
- Be majoring in a subject related to the telecommunications engineering field (an engineering major is not required).

One scholarship is available for all students, including Community College students and lower-division students:

Byron St. Clair Memorial Scholarship (up to \$1,000)

To be considered for the Byron St. Clair Memorial Scholarship, applicants must:

- Be enrolled as either part-time or full-time undergraduate or graduate student in either an associate or 4-year program at an accredited college or university or a community college or applied technical school, located in the United States or Canada.
- Be majoring in or taking courses related to broadcast engineering or technology (an engineering major is not required).

****It is recommended that you obtain an AFCCE sponsor who is a member or associate member of the association (see form page 2). If you do not obtain a sponsor, one will be selected for you.**
